

We also welcome the Arsenal stars of tomorrow here this afternoon, who we hope will follow in the footsteps of the likes of Ashley Cole, Jack Wiltshire, Bakayo Saka, Emile Smith-Rowe, Ethan Nwaneri and Myles Lewis-Skelly amongst many others, who all trod the same path and went on to play for England.

For Arsenal's youth it's often here at Meadow Park that they sit their embryonic football exams from 15/16 years of age in the AFC FA Youth Cup squads, then through promotion to the Development Squads and then the ultimate dream, a call up into the first team squad and beyond.

Trust me as a club and an environment, we are very proud of our small involvement in that process and love the

fact we have been involved with AFC for more than 30 years. Today though we also celebrate not only our partnership but our friendships and we especially celebrate the signing of two new 10 year contracts with both AFC and AWFC.

Our involvement with AFC and AWFC came from very humble beginnings back in the 90's... in truth I backed the Arsenal Women (previously known as Arsenal Ladies) back then and if I'm honest they didn't really have two pennies to rub together back then haha....

As such, I am very proud as an individual and as a club to have been involved in some small way at the very start of the AWFC journey, and to see what has been built and achieved since then by so many good people at AFC/AWFC is incredible.

Countless League Titles, FA Cups, League Cups have been won here at Meadow Park and our Arsenal Women have now proudly won two European Cups, and to think it all started with my friend Vic Akers and with some Arsenal backing all those years ago is mind boggling. That said, it's also taken many good people and plenty of AFC investment since - but my god, from very humble beginnings look where it's gone today.

I feel lucky and honoured to have been part of things way back when and even luckier to have been invited to be part of the Arsenal delegation in Lisbon for their recent Champions League final v Barcelona. I once again witnessed a victory and an Arsenal Woman's performance that will long live in the memory and all just a week after our very own BWFC play off victory over Maidstone United that secured our promotion back to the National League.

It was for me an emotional week in football that I'll never forget, it was a snap shot in time that I've worked for during my whole football life. To firstly see the joy after promotion within my home town, my community, my club, my manager, our players and my staff was joyous and utter madness.....to then see the joy on our Arsenal girls and their staffs faces just a week later in Lisbon after beating Barcelona, just reminded me why I do the things I do and invest in football like I do.

In truth it's why I still invest in the club and why I improve our stadium like I do. It's why I always look to the future and it's why I work hard to improve things here bit by bit and step by step.

My partners, sponsors and collaborators at HBC, EBTC, AFC, AWFC and the Football Foundation have also helped me enormously along the way. They know we must now finish the job at the South End of the Stadium to complete Meadow Park, they know they must help me complete my vision for the Park, for Brook Road Car Park and they know we must complete our Stadium.

It must not be forgotten, this is our community, our town and our club. These are our local residents and my fanbase and Councillors know that future proofing and legacy really does matter.

Today though is about looking after our guests in the Boardroom and on the terraces. It's about us welcoming our friends from Arsenal, it's also on a football front about getting minutes into the players, being injury free at the end of the game and about moving intelligently toward the forthcoming season and settling on our squad.

I feel these next few games will be great indicators for Luke Garrard and Charlie Hunter on what perhaps we still need player wise this season as I believe they are still very much in the market for two or three players to improve the squad.

Anyway, back to today, let's hope for an open, attacking game today and may the best team win.

Good afternoon, firstly I would like to welcome the Manager, Staff and Players of Arsenal FC to The Mangata Developments Stadium for today's annual pre-season friendly fixture.

Today's fixture is always welcome in our pre-season schedule, ever since I have been here whether as a player or Manager they have always been competitive and exactly what is required at this stage of pre-season.

For me, our games programme starts now. What I mean by that is our last two friendlies have been great for us physically and getting good work into the players, but now with seven games to go I believe we can really now start to gauge the group.

I have already seen positives in our play and the ideas in which we are working on has played out in our last two matches, but in all honesty especially on Tuesday evening it was more of us without the ball.

It's never easy against opposition higher up the pyramid, add to the fact they both make wholesale changes at the Interval, this presents a whole new challenge and is a real test to the group.

I must take all these factors into account, monitoring the lads workload at this early stage is fundamental as we are tasked to get all the players at their optimum for August 9th.

We have a plan and that includes hitting a certain metric for the number of minutes played throughout this pre-season, and with seven fixtures to go they'll be opportunities to ensure we hit exactly what the players require.

There have been mixed performances throughout the squad, some have shown already a greater understanding of what's required and others still playing catch up.

I have to constantly check myself as I must appreciate the calibre of opposition we have faced in a short space of time, but like

I told the players this week, now we will see how things are progressing in the coming weeks with our performances against sides we feel our more of a National League test.

Today we will welcome back Chris Bush and Erico Sousa, two players that will have a huge impact in our Season this year. Again, we have to box clever with Erico as he's returning from the injury he picked up in Torquay but it will be great to see him back out on the grass.

With them two returning, I have to unfortunately inform you all we will be without Jack Payne for the foreseeable as he sustained an injury to his knee in training. We are yet to know the extent of it as we are waiting for the swelling to go down to get all the relevant tests required to get a better understanding of a time frame.

This will now allow for him to go headfirst into his Assistant Manager role, and have a positive impact on the group being involved more with the management.

I'm hoping in the coming days we will be announcing more additions to the squad, it has been a very busy period for recruitment, and we have some targets I know will excite the fans and most definitely improve the group.

Gaffer for the Arsenal XI, Max Porter is a former midfielder who played for nine English clubs, including Newport County, where he helped secure promotion to the Football League in 2013. After retiring in 2019 at Chelmsford City, he transitioned into coaching with the Gunners, having held roles from U13 coach to U21 assistant. In the 2024/25 season, Porter became head coach of Arsenal's U19s in the UEFA Youth League. The young manager is also an FAW UEFA Pro Licence candidate, continuing his development as a top-level coach.

Jack PORTER

Born: 15 July 2008

Position: Goalkeeper

A young prospect between the sticks, Porter joined the Gunners in 2020 and signed scholarship terms in 2024. Promoted to third-choice keeper after an injury crisis, he made his professional debut at just 16 years and 72 days old in a Carabao Cup match against Bolton under the Emirates Stadium lights, becoming the second youngest player to ever start for Arsenal. Internationally, Porter has represented England at U16 and U17 levels and was selected for the 2025 UEFA European Under-17 Championship.



Charles SAGOE Jr

Born: 24 July 2004

Position: Forward

Sagoe Jr. joined Arsenal's academy at under 12 level after starting at Fulham and after years of developments at Hale End, the winger has gone onto feature for Arsenal's U21s in the EFL Trophy and make his senior debut in September of 2023 away to Brentford in the Carabao Cup. Last year, Sagoe Jr. had loan spells at Swansea City and Shrewsbury Town to gain first-team experience, returning to Arsenal in January and continuing his development as a promising young talent.



Sebastian FERDINAND

Born: 12 January 2006

Position: Forward

A tricky right winger with an eye for goal, local lad from nearby St Albans, Sebastian Ferdinand joined the Gunners in 2020 after playing youth football in London Colney. A product of Hale End, he made 21 appearances across youth competitions during the 2023/24 season, scoring twice in both the U18 Premier League and Bristol Street Motors Trophy. His standout performance came against Exeter City's first team, where he netted twice and assisted once in a 5-0 win.

Wood fell to a 4-2 defeat last time out against an Arsenal XI at Meadow Park, a game that featured the likes of Hale End stars, Myles Lewis-Skelly and Ethan Nwaneri.

The young Gunners started fast, scoring twice in the first ten minutes through Ismail Oulad M'Hand and Omar Reikik. Kwesi Appiah would then give Wood hope, heading home after a goalmouth scramble to make it 2-1.

The Gunners restored their two-goal cushion before the break, Salah-Eddine finishing well for his second. Ethan Nwaneri added a fourth just after half-time before Trialist C pulled one back for Wood midway through the second half, converting after good build-up play from Charles Clayden.

Wood pushed for more, with Trialist D and C both going close late on, one shot blocked on the line and another volley flying over. Despite the defeat, the friendly offered valuable minutes and encouraging signs as preparations continued for the eventual promotion-winning National League South campaign ahead.

Luke Garrard's men in white put in a disciplined display but were ultimately beaten 2-0 by Championship side Watford in their second pre-season outing at Mangata Developments Stadium Meadow Park.

The Hornets dominated possession early on, but Wood's defence held firm until a loose pass allowed Imran Louza to fire home from the edge of the box on 27 minutes. Prior to that, Nathan Ashmore had made smart saves to deny Louza and Mamadou Doumbia, while Junior Dixon tested Nathan Baxter at the other end.

After the break, both sides made wholesale changes. Mattie Pollock was twice denied by Ashmore, but Watford eventually found their second through Amin Nabizada's tidy finish midway through the half. Ashmore continued to impress, pulling off a key save to stop Pierre Dwomoh, while Matt Rush came closest for Wood late on, drawing a fine save from Baxter.

Despite the result, Wood showed great resilience and gained valuable minutes against strong opposition.



HISTORY REPEATS ITSELF: Arsenal Women become TWO TIME European Champions!

It was a night that stirred memories and rewrote history in equal measure. Almost 18 years on from their first European triumph, a famous day here at our Meadow Park home, Arsenal Women have once again climbed to the summit of European football, capturing the UEFA Women's Champions League title for a second time.

The road to Lisbon was not an easy one, and the final proved every bit the battle that fans expected. Arsenal faced a formidable Barcelona side who came into the match as

favourites, as reigning champions, and dominant forces in the women's game. But football, as we know, is about moments. And when the moment came, it was the Gunners who seized it.

Played in the electric atmosphere of Lisbon's Estádio da Luz, the match began with both sides showing attacking intent. Barcelona had the better of the early chances, with Daphne van Domselaar, who had a phenomenal campaign between the sticks, being called into action multiple times. Her early intervention

to deny Ewa Pajor set the tone for a composed and commanding performance.

Arsenal showed their mettle and slowly began to assert themselves. Caitlin Foord and Kim Little combined to trouble the Barcelona defence, and Frida Maanum looked to have forced an own goal midway through the first half, only for VAR to intervene with an offside decision. It was a let off for the Blaugrana, and yet another twist in what was becoming a nervy and tightly contested final.

Despite Barcelona's pressing and an impressive shift from Ballon d'Or winner Aitana Bonmatí, Arsenal's back line, marshalled by Leah Williamson and ably supported

by Emily Fox, remained resolute. There was a steely resolve in Jonas Eidevall's side, one that has been honed through years of near-misses and hard-earned lessons.

As the second half wore on, the pressure mounted. Barcelona dominated possession and peppered the Arsenal goal with efforts. Van Domselaar stood tall, or more often, sprang low, to deny Bonmatí, Claudia Pina, and Ona Batlle in quick succession. A shot off the crossbar and another scrambled off the line highlighted just how close Barcelona came to breaking through.

In the 67th minute, Arsenal made two bold substitutions. On came Stina Blackstenius and Beth Mead,






a duo whose quality is well known to Meadow Park regulars. Just seven minutes later, their impact was felt around Europe. Mead, drifting into the right channel, played a beautifully weighted reverse pass into the stride of Blackstenius, who coolly slotted the ball into the far corner. 1-0 to The Arsenal.

From that moment, it was about discipline and determination. Arsenal saw out the final 15 minutes, and several nerve-wracking minutes of stoppage time, to claim their first UEFA Women's Champions League title since that magical day at Meadow Park in 2007.
