The pre-season games to date will have sharpened us up, but the next few games are I feel true indicators for Luke and Charlie in regard to what is perhaps still needed player wise and as I've said, we are still very much in the market for two or three players to finalise the squad.

#### Good afternoon, firstly I would like to welcome the Manager, Staff and Players of Tottenham Hotspur FC to The Mangata Developments Stadium for today's pre-season friendly fixture.

I would like to thank Wayne for bringing over his side, as this will give us the much needed test we require at this stage of pre-season.

I feel we have been progressing really well, and have shown a level of growth since our first few performances and we are now seeing a sharpness to our play.

The pre-season schedule has lent itself nicely to a steady return of minutes for the players and we are now starting to build them up with longer game time which will aid them and their fitness levels.

On Tuesday evening we see a performance that started to combine all the elements we are working on, it allowed for us to have more dominance in our possession and also showed more of our attacking threats.

We have been drumming into the players the importance of being aggressive with and without the ball and I felt we see that on several occasions especially when pressing in the final third.

I won't shy away from the fact we conceded 3 goals, and the manner in which we did, but it has to improve and as a group we spoke in depth about my expectations and how I envisage us moving forward.

We know we are going to be slightly more open on transition, as we are asking the players to make the pitch big but our pitch geography and understanding of when we need to balance off and have security in and around the ball is going to be key.

I have been impressed with our fitness levels, that was very evident on Tuesday night, our regains and counter press showed aggression and that is how we will have to operate when offering up the ball in the final third.

My overall assessment of the first three weeks is one of positivity, embedding the new recruits, implementing an improved style into the group and I feel we are seeing improvements day by day.

Some players are staking a claim for a start on August 9th, and others need to up their game. That's the beauty of pre-season, everyone has the opportunity to nail a shirt and I feel some have done just that.

We now turn our focus back to this afternoon, where we will have the opportunity to continue to progress and build on what's been a positive start to our pre-season.

We know we are mid-way through our schedule and the games start to become more relevant to what we will be used to facing week in week out in the National League and the players will start to get a feel for what August 9th might look like.

Over the coming weeks we will be demanding even more out of the players and the expectations really get set, we know we still have areas to improve on and that's a task we will be setting the players.

We also appreciate we need to add to this group, we have been in a privileged position with the amount of players we have to our disposal and have been pretty particular with our next few signings as they have to be of real quality.

We know what we have available, and we know this next part of our recruitment will be key in transforming the dressing room.

Let's hope you enjoy the game



Will LANKSHEAR

Born: 20 April 2005 Position: Forward

Will Lankshear joined Spurs' Academy from Sheffield United in August of 2022. Formerly with Arsenal, he captained the Blades' U18s to an unbeaten title win in 2021/22. Born in nearby Welwyn Garden City, Lankshear lead the scoring charts for Spurs' title-winning U21s in 2023/24 and was named Premier League 2 Player of the Season. The forward made his senior debut last year against Ferencvaros, going on to score away at Galatasaray in Spurs' Europa League winning campaign.



Mikey MOORE

Born: 11 August 2007 Position: Midfield

Attacking midfielder, Mikey Moore joined Spurs' Academy aged seven and rose through the ranks to make his first team debut in May of last year. A standout at youth level, he helped win the U17 and U18 Premier League Cups in 2022/23, scoring twice in the U17 final. He became Spurs' youngestever U21 player at 15, has starred for England at various youth levels and impressed in last season's Europa League campaign.



Jamie DONLEY

Born: 3 January 2005 Position: Forward

Donley is a left-footed centre-forward born in Antrim, Northern Ireland, and raised near Colchester, joining Spurs aged eight and scoring on his U18 debut in 2020. A key part of the team that won the U17 and U18 Premier League Cups in 2022/23, he also made early strides with the U21s. Donley started 2023/24 strongly, earning a Premier League 2 Player of the Month nomination and now represents England at youth level, having previously played for Northern Ireland.

Kieran Adams and Emil Hallfredsson were on target as a Spurs XI were held to a 1-1 draw by the Wood at Meadow Park.

Wood took a surprise lead in the 10th minute against the run of play. Joe O'Brien delivered a cross from the left, Paul Burrows nodded it down, and Kieran Adams reacted quickest to drill the ball past David Button from 12 yards. Spurs XI dominated possession throughout the first half but were unable to convert their pressure into goals. Jamie Davis broke the offside trap and looked to square for Jamie O'Hara or Andy Barcham, only for his cross to be intercepted.

Charlie Daniels dragged a shot wide, Barcham flicked a header just off target, and Charlie Lee forced a fine save from keeper Noel Imber with a powerful header. Emil Hallfredsson also went close, delivering a teasing cross that Barcham poked inches wide.



The visitors picked up where they left off after the break. O'Hara struck the crossbar with a curling effort, and Barcham grazed the post after Davis won possession high up the pitch.

The equaliser came in the 54th minute, O'Hara picking out Hallfredsson's well-timed run with the Icelandic international finishing coolly into the corner. Hallfredsson remained at the heart of the action late on, firing one shot that Lovell tipped onto the post and then supplying two superb crosses that led to close-range chances for Radwan Hamed and Jacques Maghoma, both denied by Lovell.

Tom Whelan also impressed, forcing a smart save from Donkin and narrowly missing the target with two more efforts.
